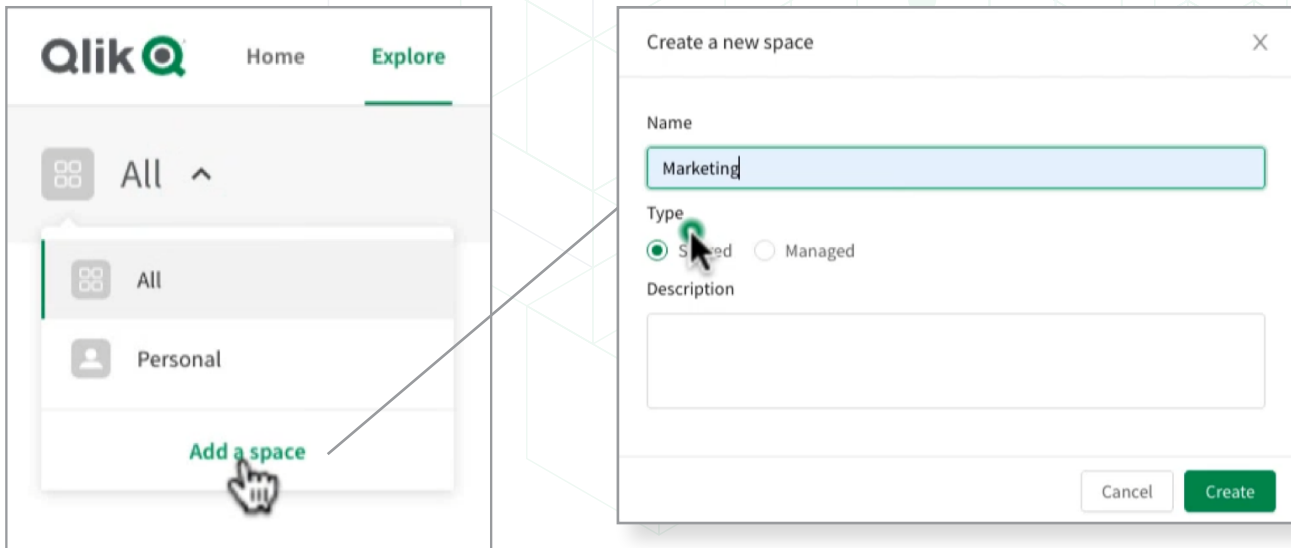


# Moving Apps from Qlik Sense® Cloud to Qlik Sense® Business

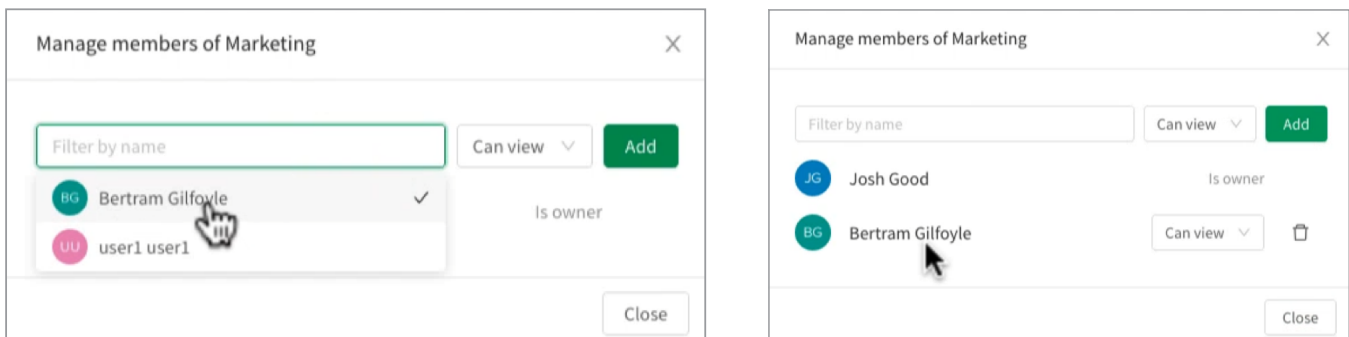
## PREPARING THE QLIK SENSE BUSINESS SPACE

1. Add Space in Qlik Sense Business by clicking “Add a space” from your space menu
2. Give the new space a name



3. Add members to space and select their access level – i.e.: Can view, edit

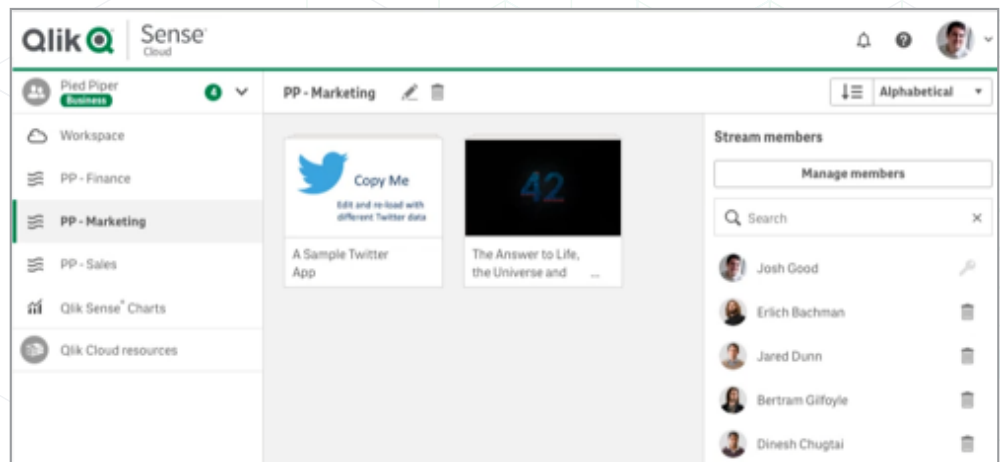
Note: members must be previously invited or existing. If you do not see any members, please invite members from the Home page.



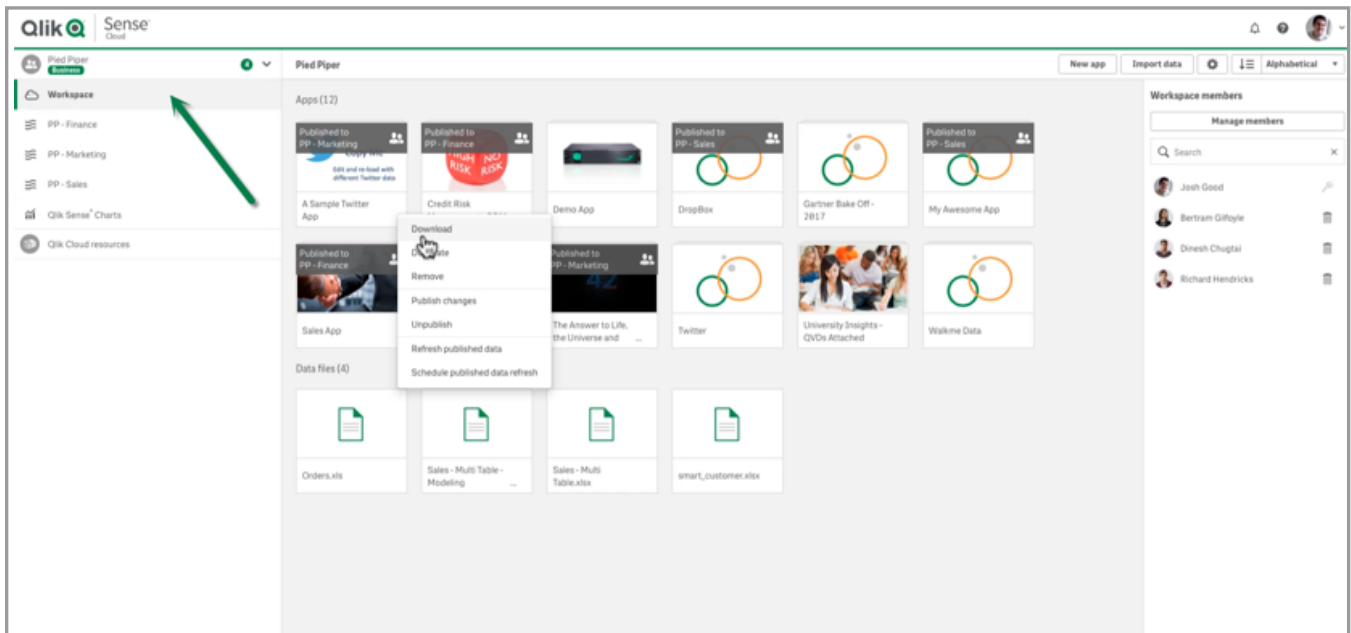
## GETTING THE APP FROM QLIK SENSE CLOUD

4. Go to your instance of Qlik Sense Cloud Business or Basic.

5. If you are using Qlik Sense Cloud Business select your

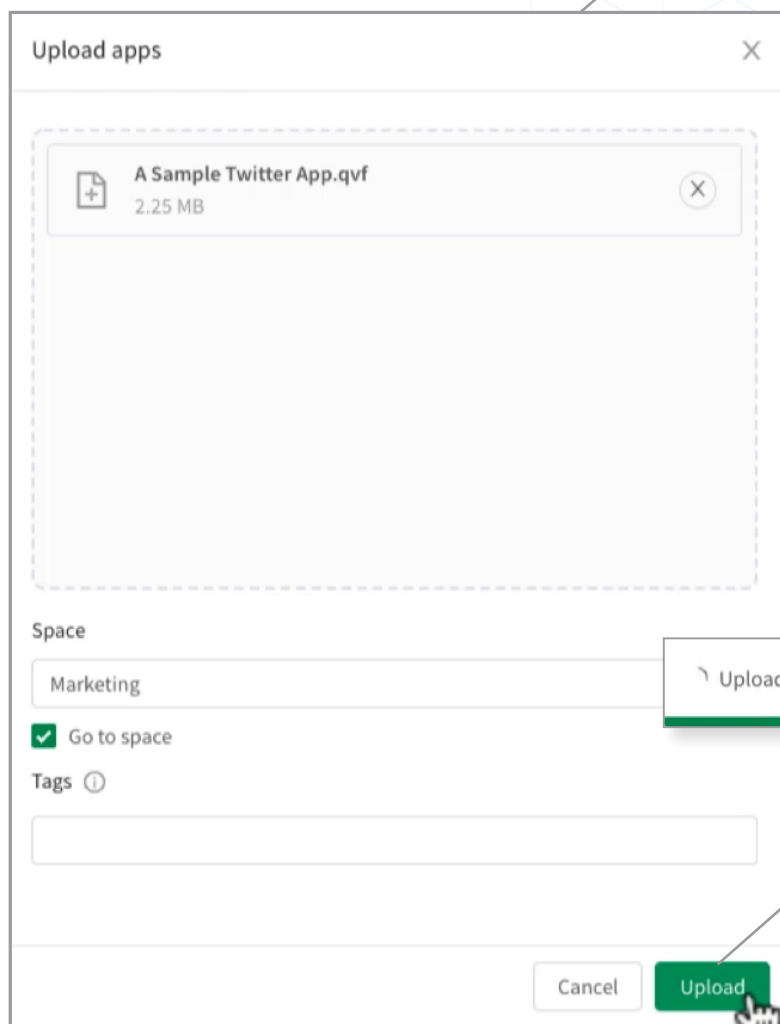
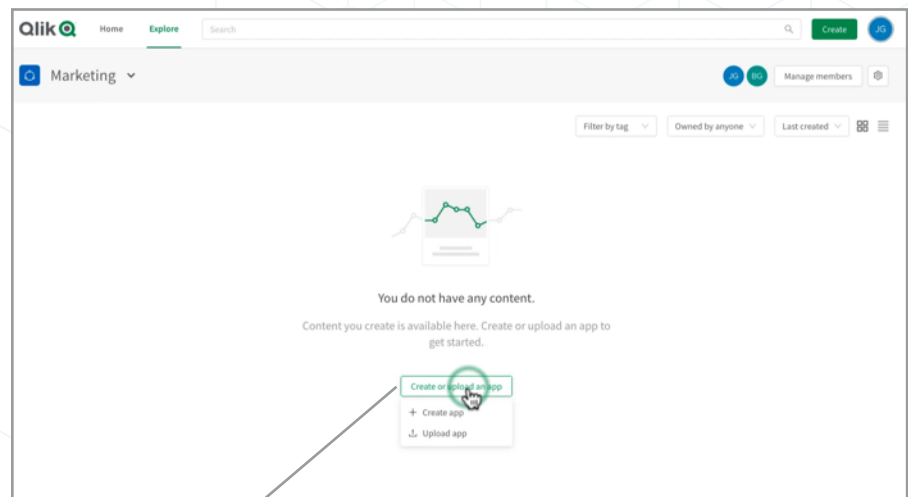


Qlik Sense Business Context and navigate to Workspace where your apps are. Right click the app and choose download from the pop up menu. Your .QVF (app) file will be downloaded to the location of your choice or the default downloads directory depending on your operating system and browser configuration. Repeat this process for each workspace area and app you want to move.



## IMPORTING THE APP TO QLIK SENSE BUSINESS

6. Return to your instance of Qlik Sense Business and while in the space you previously created, choose the “Create or upload an app” button and choose “Upload app”

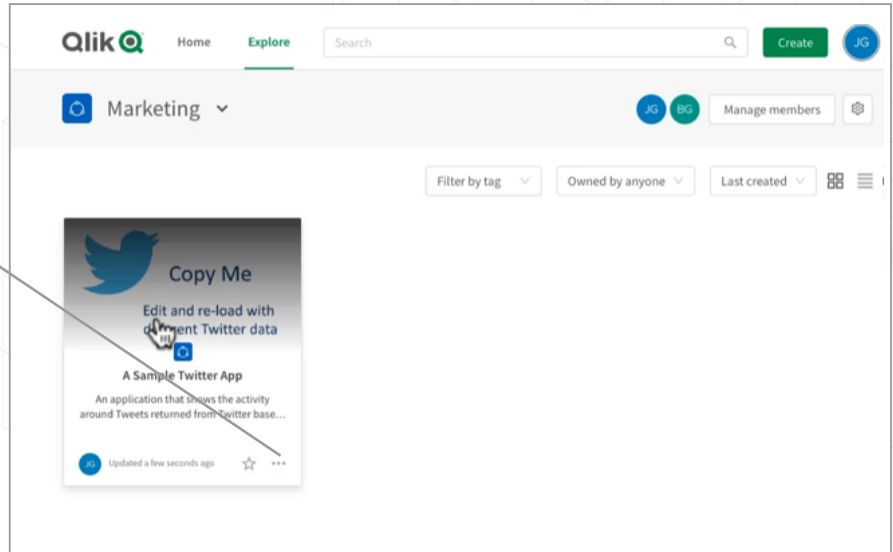
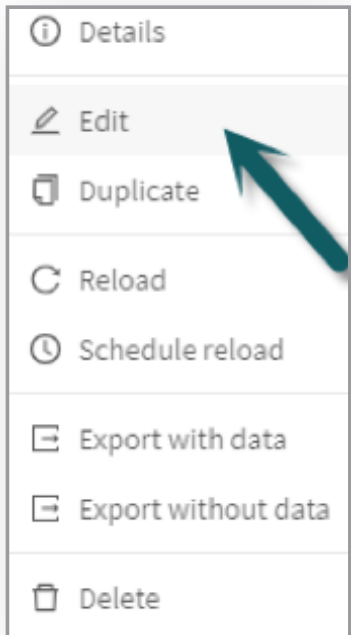


7. Browse and navigate to the location on your filesystem. Locate the .QVF file, select and click “Upload” – this will add the app to Qlik Sense Business.

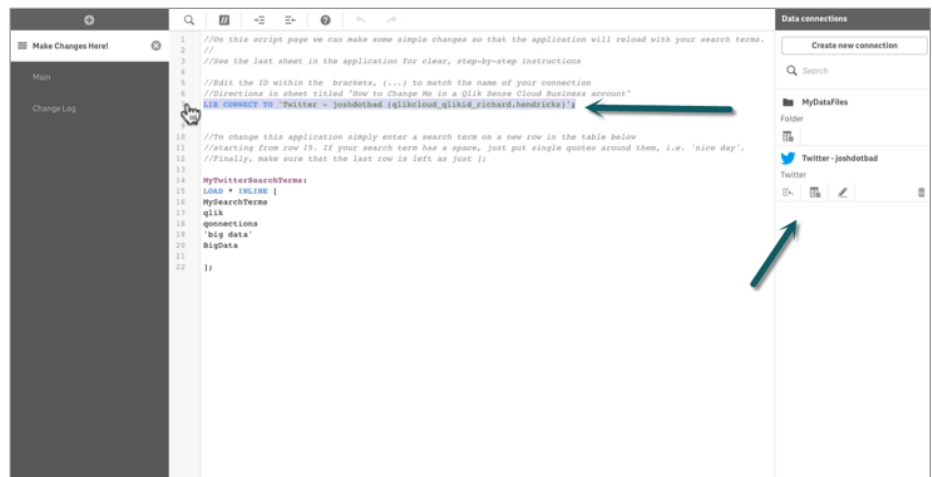
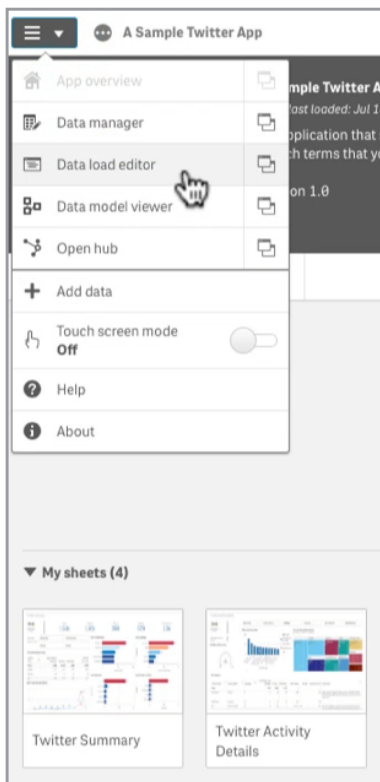


## SETTING UP THE DATA CONNECTION

8. Select the app "... " (ellipsis) button and choose Edit



9. In the App Overview, navigate to the menu and Select Data Load editor

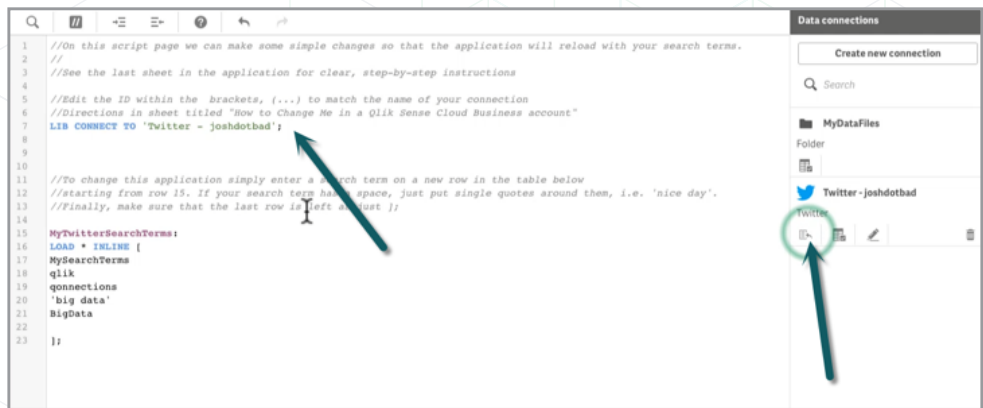


10. Add your new data connection by clicking the “Create data connection” button. Refer to [Adding Data Sources in the Qlik Help](#) if you need a refresher on how to create a data connections.

Locate your existing data connections connect string and delete it.

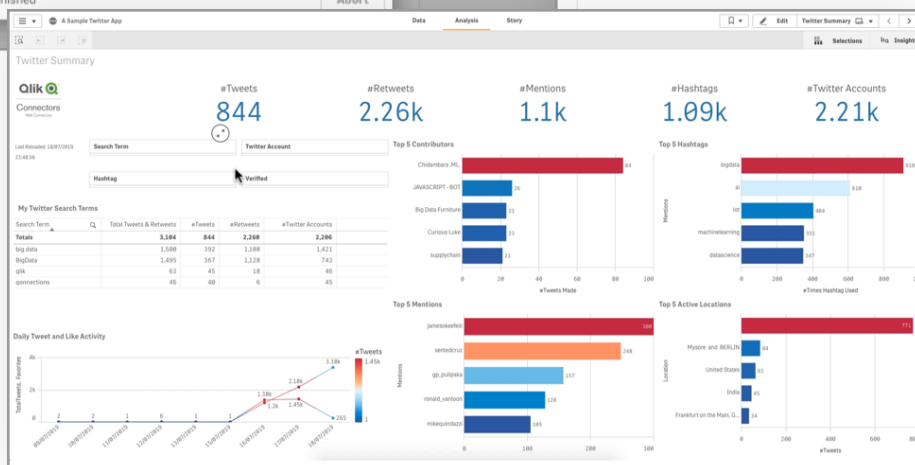
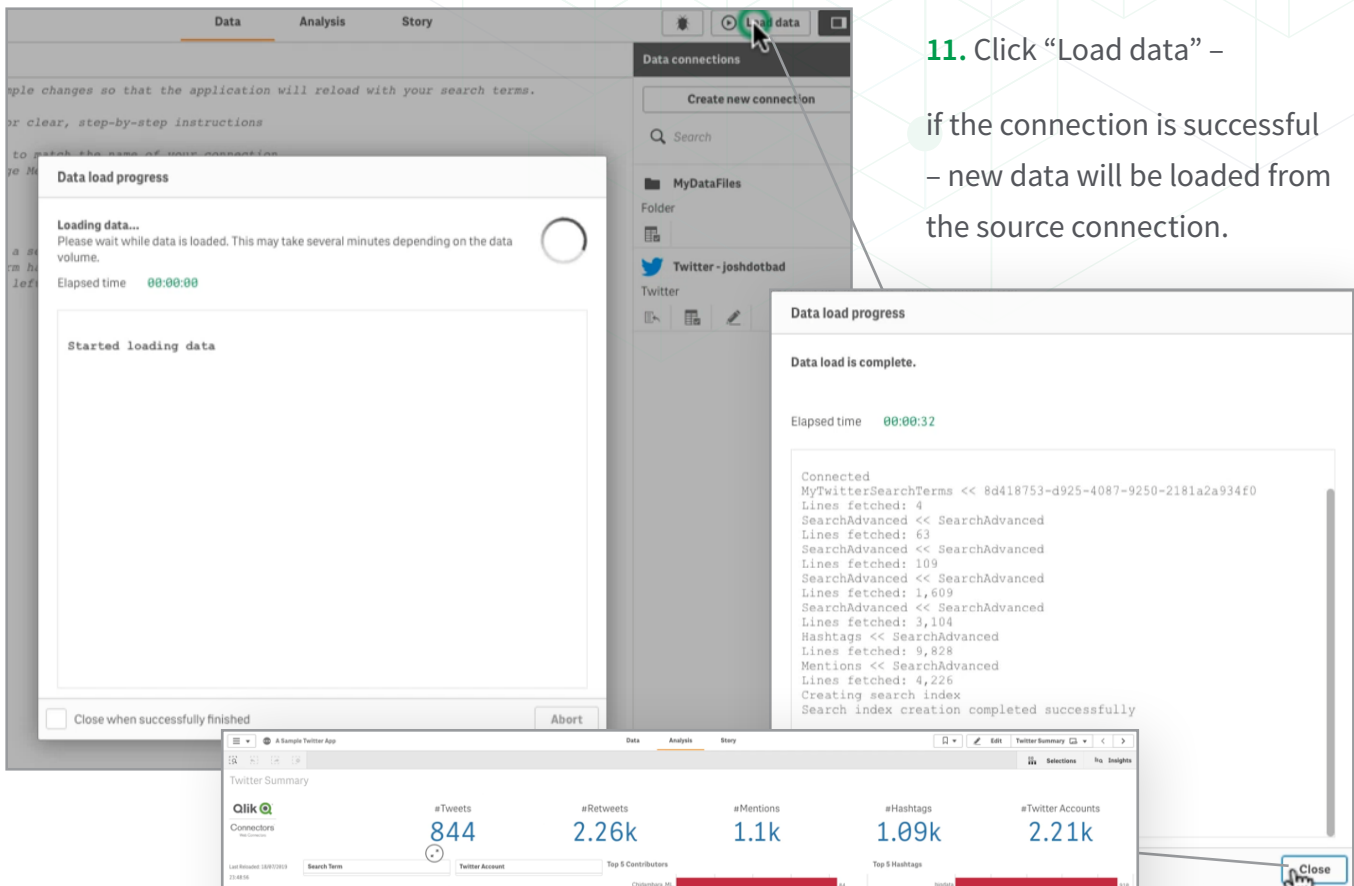
## SETTING UP THE DATA CONNECTION

Insert the cursor in the same location as the older connect string



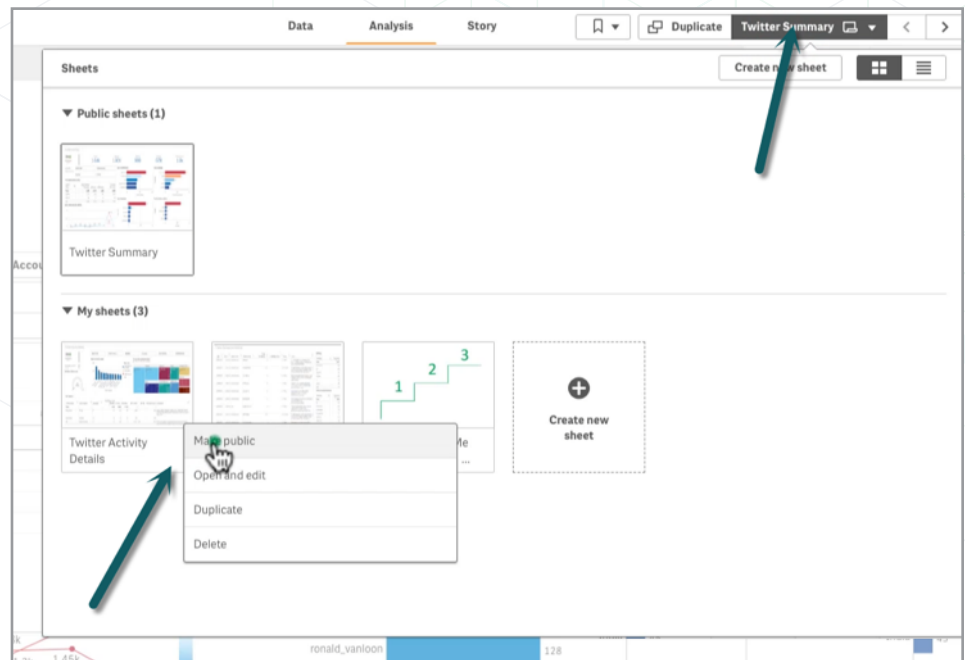
11. Click "Load data" -

if the connection is successful - new data will be loaded from the source connection.

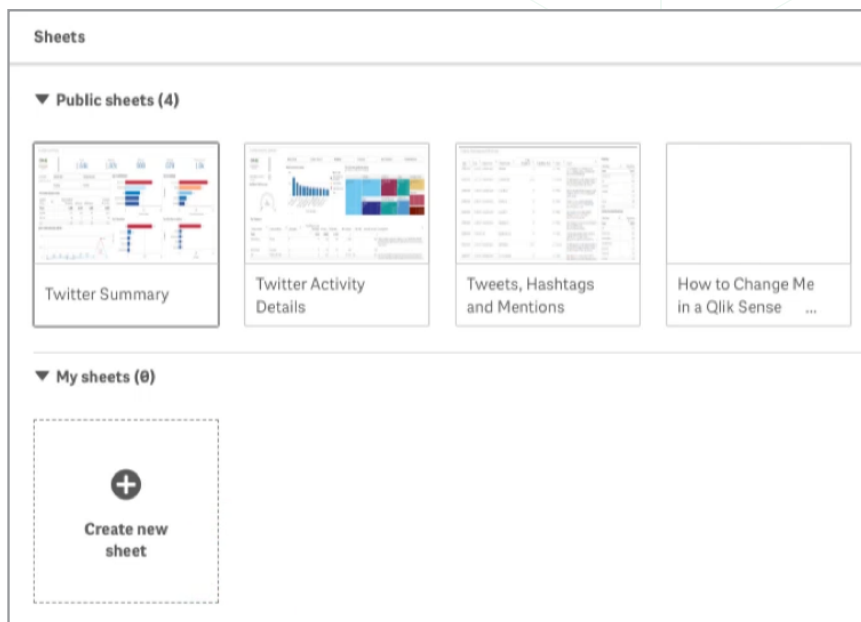


## MAKING SHEETS PUBLISHED – IF APPLICABLE, DEPENDS ON SECURITY CONFIGURATION

12. Select sheet selector and locate sheets under My Sheets section. Right click sheet you want to make public and choose “Make public”. Repeat this step for all sheets you want others to view.
